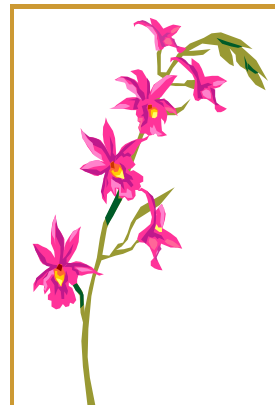
### Infants
