## INFANTS

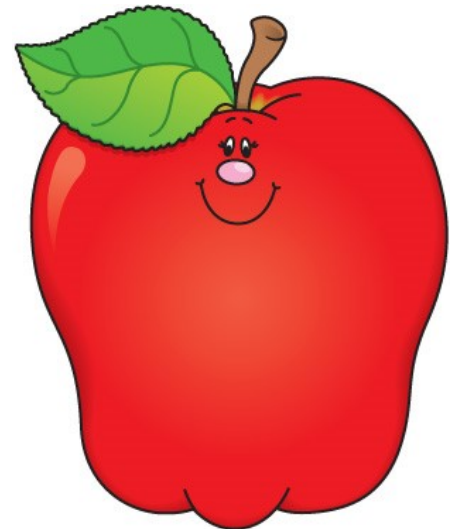

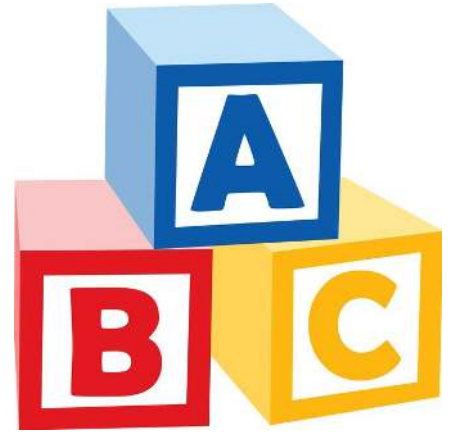
