We ask for your support to reach and help as many babies as possible, making sure they have enough diapers to stay healthy, safe, and clean.

□ 5.3 million children in the U.S. aged three or younger live in poor or low-income families.
□ 1 in 3 American families reports experiencing diaper need.
□ Diapers cannot be obtained with food stamps.
□ Disposable diapers cost \$70 to \$80 per month <i>per baby.</i>
□ No state or federal child safety-net program allocates dollars specifically for the purchase of diapers.
$\hfill \Box$ Without transportation, buying diapers at a convenience store rather than a large "big box" store can significantly increase the monthly cost of diapers.
□ Infants require up to 12 diapers per day, toddlers about 8.
