Don't forget to change your clocks back an hour on November 1st! Thanks for all of your continued support!

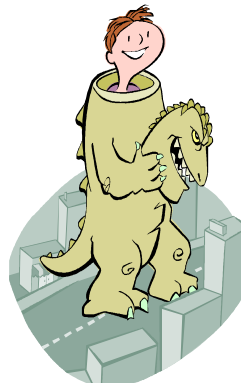
