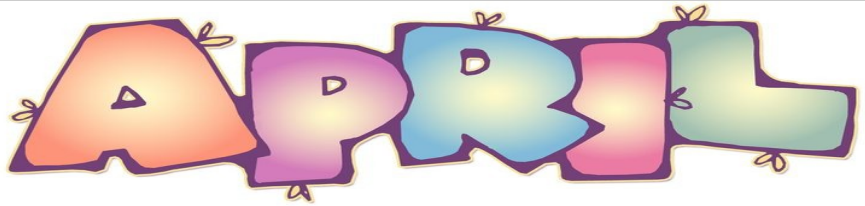

SICK CHILD POLICY:



Your child's health is very important to us, as well as the health of the other students and staff members.

If your child has any of these symptoms they are NOT allowed to return to school until they are 24 hours symptom free. If your child is sent home with any of these symptoms, a "Red Slip" will need to be signed, stating that you understand our sick policy and that your child CANNOT return until they are 24 hours symptom free.

- . **Fever (100* or higher under the arm)***
- . **Diarrhea***
- . **Vomiting***
- . **Rash***
- . **Heavy Nasal Secretion***
- . **Conjunctivitis (Pink Eye)***
- . **Severe Coughing or Wheezing***
- . **Severe Cold Symptoms***
