

## SICK CHILD POLICY:

If your child is sent home with any of these symptoms, a "Red Slip" will need to be signed, stating that you understand our sick policy and that your child <u>CANNOT</u> return until they are 24 hours symptom free.

- Fever (100\* or higher under the arm)
- . Diarrhea
- . Vomiting
- . Rash
- . Heavy Nasal Secretion
- . Conjunctivitis (Pink Eye)
- . Severe Coughing or Wheezing
- . Severe Cold Symptoms
