Please make sure your child comes DRESSED in their bathing suits on their scheduled water day! We ask that you bring in your child a: **LABELED** towel, & a **LABELED** extra change of clothes. All students MUST wear water shoes, to ensure the safety of the children. If your child wears diapers, please remember to apply a swim diaper OVER there regular diaper!
