# March 2017 Classroom News!!

#### **Developmental 1—**

Spring time is just around the corner, which means warmer weather!!! We're reminding all of our parents to make sure that their child has an extra change of clothes in their cubby. Please make sure that your child's nails are regularly clipped and trimmed. We want to welcome Stella D & Savannah to our class!. There are many fun events happening this month, Dr. Seuss Week, picture day and St Patrick's Day. Please make sure that your child always has diapers and that everything is labeled as there is often duplicates of things. #### **Developmental 2B**—

Check your child's cubby to make sure they have a weather appropriate change of clothing in his or her cubby, two full sets are ideal. We use community wipes in our classroom for many purposes. 
