Wellington Policies/Reminders

VPK Program

The VPK program will being Thursday August, 8th! Reminder for our VPK parents, if your child is enrolled in the VPK program, he/she must be in attendance by 8:30AM for morning session or 1:30pm for afternoon session.

Naptime:

A small blanket is important part to help settle a child into the rest period of the day. The blanket must be small enough to fit in your child's cubby, also the cubby must be able to close completely. We are required per DCF to have a sheet on each child's sleeping mat, a crib sized sheet is encouraged.

Dress Code:

For the safety of the children, no flip flops may be worn. All shoes must have a back. Rubber sole shoes are most comfortable and safe, dress clothes & jewelry are strongly discouraged.

Please Remember:

Wellington Academy has a cut off time for children to be dropped off in the morning, as well as to be picked up in the afternoon. Most of the learning time is done between 8:30-9:30am, so we encourage for you to bring your child in before then. If for some reason you can not bring them in before then please call our front office to notify them. Our facility closes at 6pm, if you are unable to pick up your child by then please call us so that we can notify our staff. Or you might be charged a pickup fee of \$9 per 5 minute period in cash, per child.

Tuition:

Tuition is due on the Friday BEFORE the first day of attendance. Your child's tuition is considered LATE after Monday morning. The late fee is \$40!

Did You Know...?

All items brought to school should be labeled with your child's first & last name or initials so that it does not go missing!
