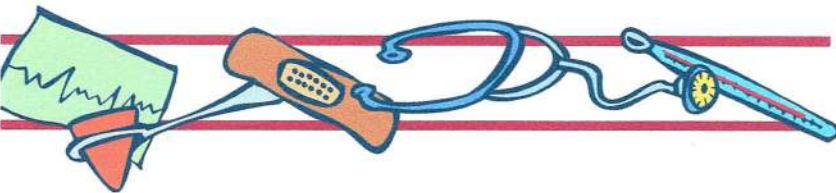

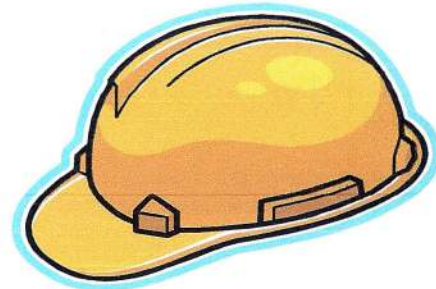

Developmental Four— The school year is a off to a great start and August was a productive month for our students in the four year old classroom! September is all about community

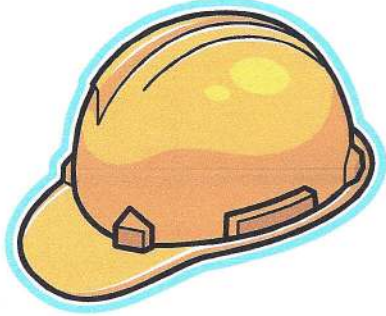

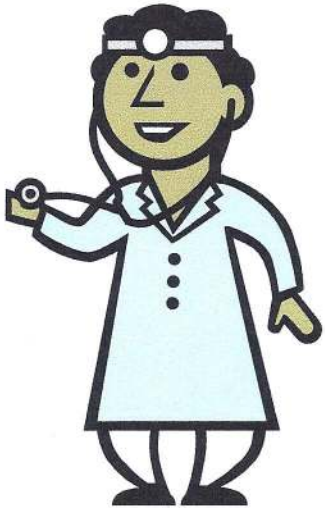
