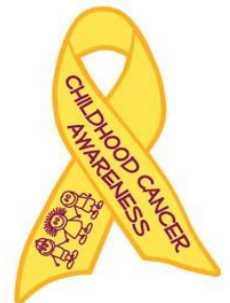
VPK C/D

Childhood Cancer Awareness Month

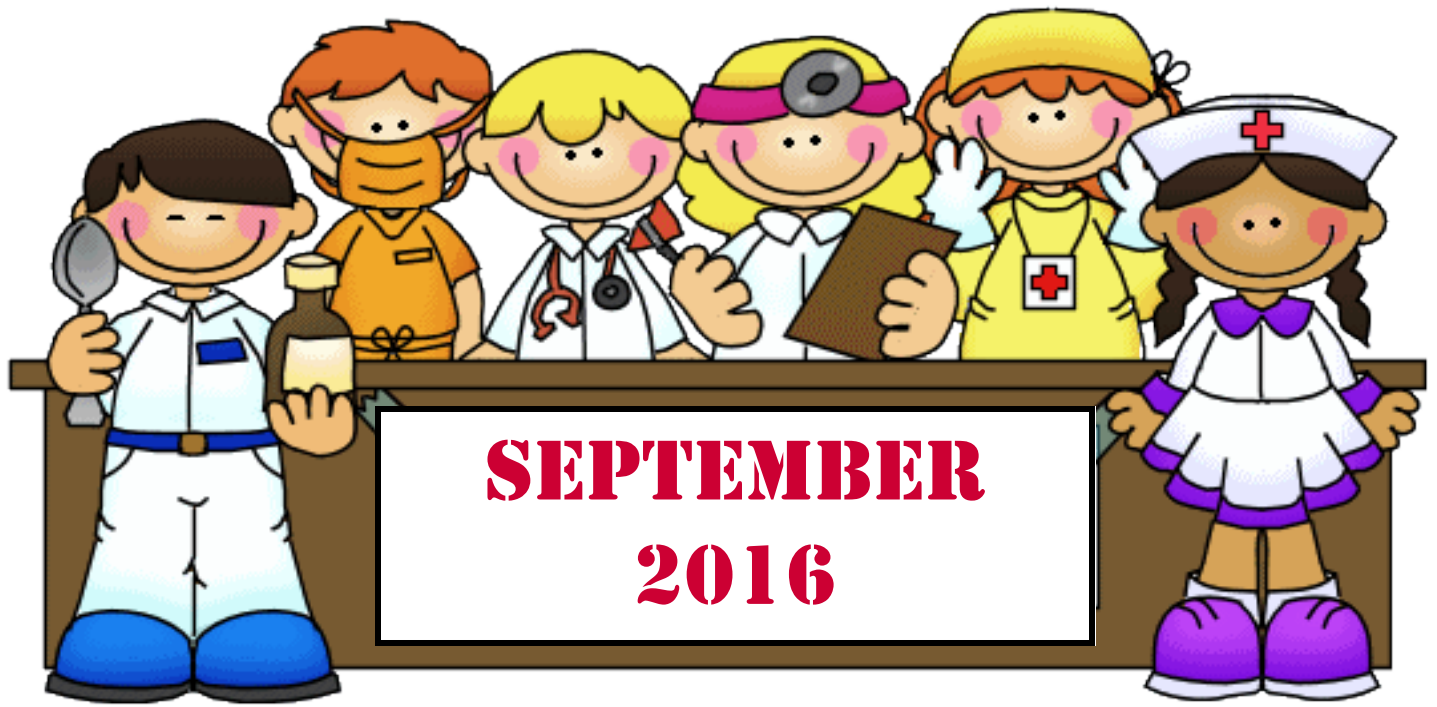
Friday, September 16th we are asking that all children wear YELLOW to support childhood cancer awareness!!
