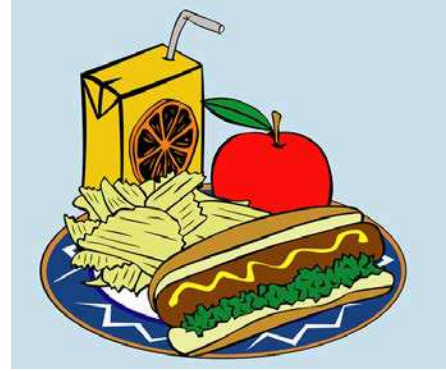


VPK News
