Development 2's News

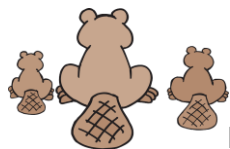
Fall into November with us. This month we will be learning about Families. We will also be talking and sharing about our families. This is going to be a great month of learning and sharing.

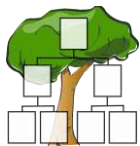
