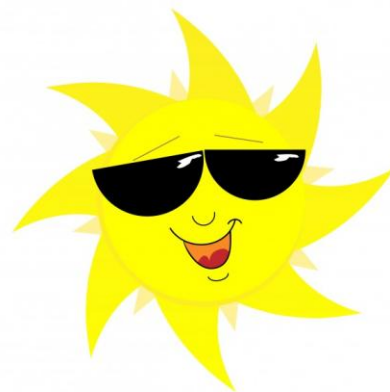

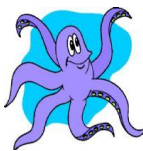

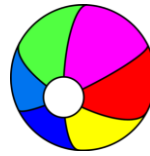
Development 3A's News
