Development 3A's News

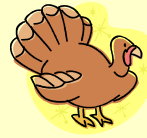

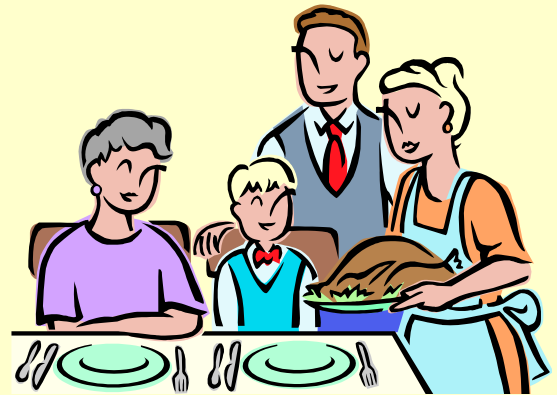


Developmental 3B News
