Angels in Diapers is dedicated to help the many parents who cannot afford to buy diapers for their babies. Below are some very heart breaking statistics and it is our goal to help our community. We ask for your support to reach and help as many babies as possible, making sure they have enough diapers to stay healthy, safe, and clean.

□ 5.3 million children in the U.S. aged three or younger live in poor or low-income families.
□ 1 in 3 American families reports experiencing diaper need.
□ Diapers cannot be obtained with food stamps.
□ Disposable diapers cost \$70 to \$80 per month <i>per baby.</i>
□ No state or federal child safety-net program allocates dollars specifically for the purchase of diapers.
$\hfill \Box$ Without transportation, buying diapers at a convenience store rather than a large "big box" store can significantly increase the monthly cost of diapers.
□ Infants require up to 12 diapers per day, toddlers about 8.
