We hope everyone enjoys there 4th of July celebrations.

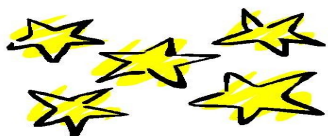

We would like to wish Brighton and Elijah good luck as they move to their new classroom.

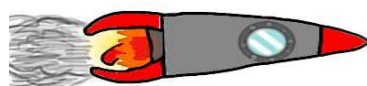
We would also like to welcome Nina and Avery to our class we are happy to learn and grow together.

We would like to welcome Hanna, Luca and Blake to our class. We are so happy to learn and grow together.

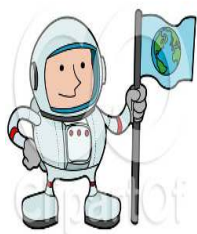
We are working on our ABC's and numbers 1-10 this month for review. Thank you for sharing your child with us.
