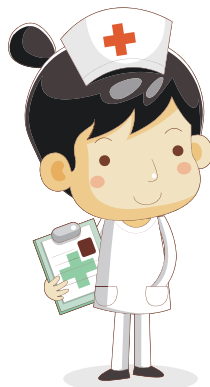
## D3
