Pre-K

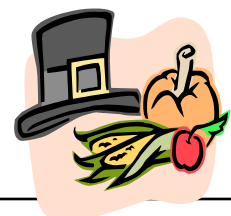

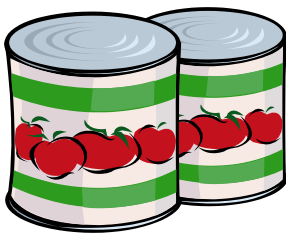
VPK
