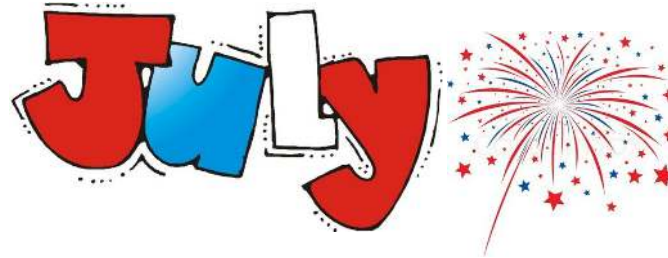

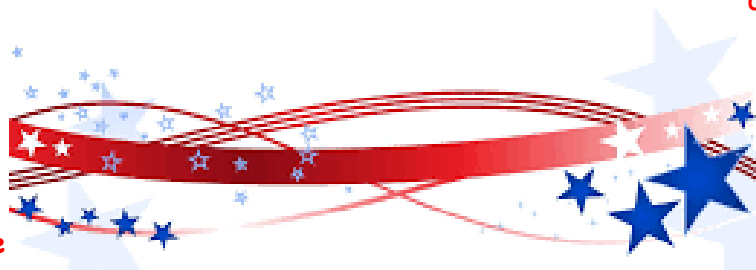

"At The Circus", "Around the world" and "All Star Sports".

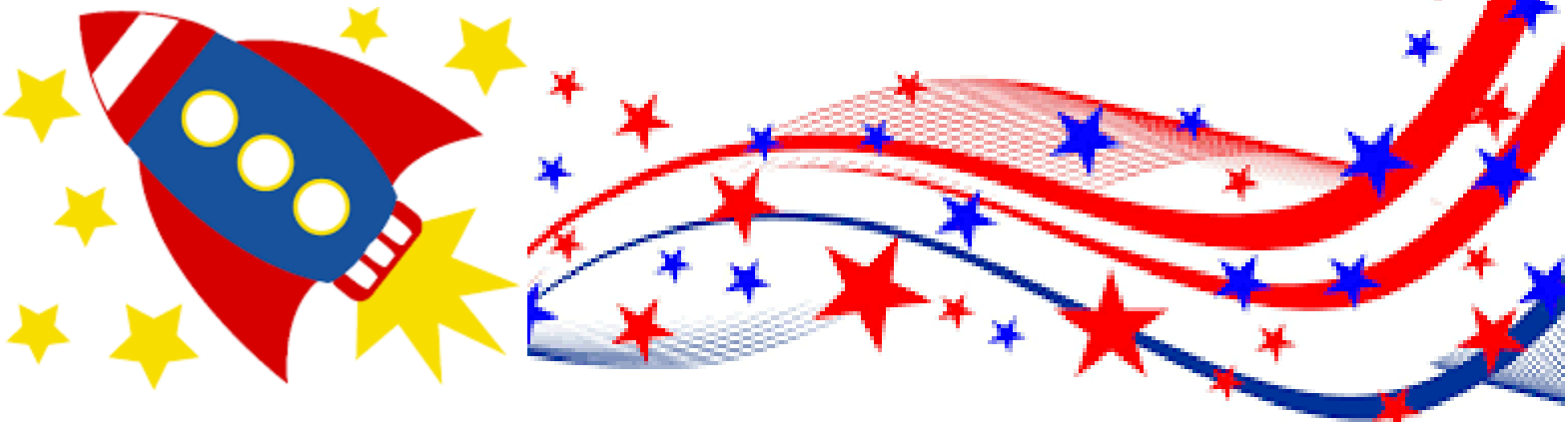
