We will be reviewing all the numbers, we have learned so far and continue on with Q,R,S,T, hexagon and diamond, and blue and silver.

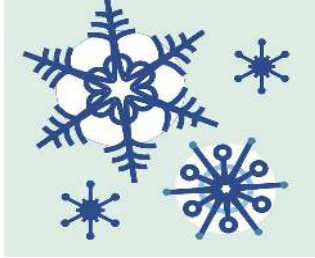
