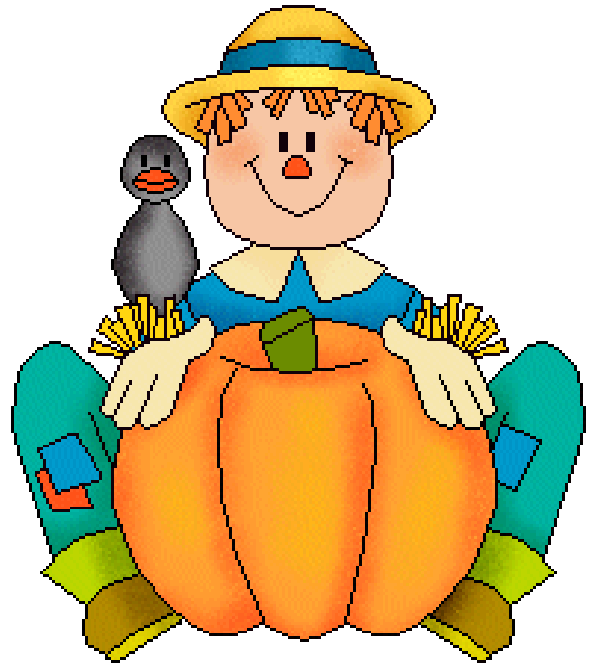
### 3A/3C
