READING at Home with Your Child

HERE ARE A FEW TIPS AND IDEAS TO HELP CULTIVATE A LOVE OF PEADING AT HOME!

- Let them hold the book as you read
- · Allow them to turn the pages
- Invite them to read with you
- · Let them finish the sentences if reading with you
- Point to the words as you read so they associate words with reading
- · Model reading in front of your child
- · Go to the library
- Encourage them to read the pictures and talk about them
- Read the same 2-3 books every day for a week, then switch.
- Read to them daily
- Designate a "reading time" where the whole family sits down to read
- Allow them to choose books
- Talk about the books after reading them
- Be excited about reading with your child. It's contagious!
