It is officially summer break and we are ready for all that comes with summertime! Water days and ices to keep us cool!


We will begin water fun while on the playground. Please be sure to send your child with appropriate water gear. You will receive notification regarding your child's classes chosen day /s

# upcoming VPK and Alumni


