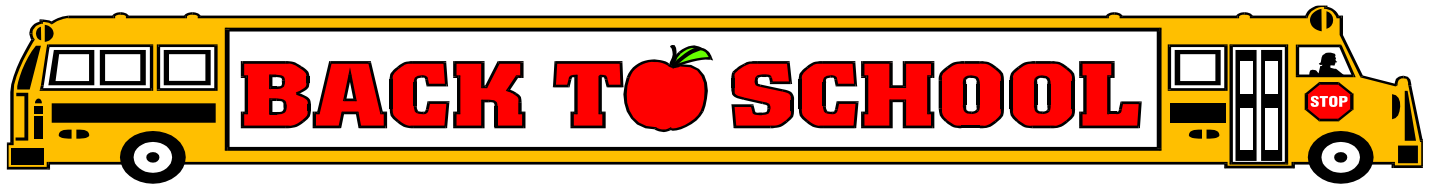
VPK B

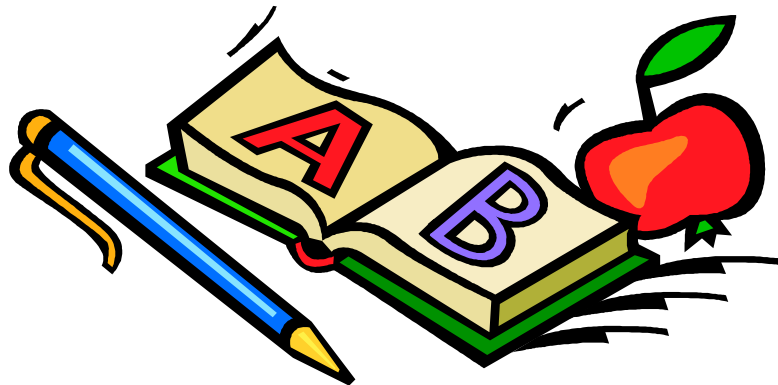

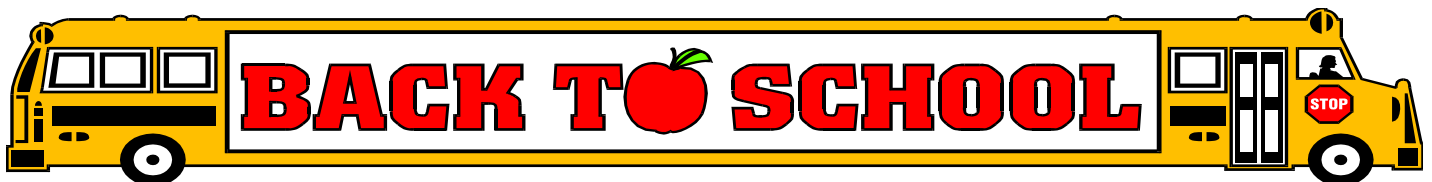

- Wellington Academy's drop-off time is **9:00am**. If for some reason you are not able bring your child in before this time, please call the front office to let us know what time your child's teachers can expect him or her!
- **VPK Parents:** your child's attendance is very important to their education...have your child here every day to ensure that they will be Kindergarten ready! They will need to be here by 8:30 or 9 depending on the class they are attending.
- Tuition is due on the **1st** and the **15th** for Monthly accounts, it is late as of the 2nd and the 16th. For weekly accounts it is due on **Monday** morning, it is late by Tuesday morning. If your payment is not made by the due date a \$40 late fee will be applied.
- For your child's **safety**, as well as the safety of other children, please make sure you are following the entrance and exit signs in the parking lot, accordingly. Please only use the handicap spots if you are indeed handicapped.
- Breakfast is served from 7:00am until 8:30am. If you do not wish for your child to eat school breakfast and bring in breakfast from home, please make sure it is **balanced** and **healthy**. If your child requires a lunch be brought in from home, please make sure you have a doctors note saying so. It also has to follow state food guide regulations.
- Wellington Academy follows the Lee County School Districts closure policy in regards to **weather or natural disasters**. This means that if the School District close school, Wellington is also closed. When school is out VPK is also out.
- Please make sure that the Front Office has your **current email** on file, this helps us ensure that you are receiving our monthly newsletters as well as any other important announcements we may have.
