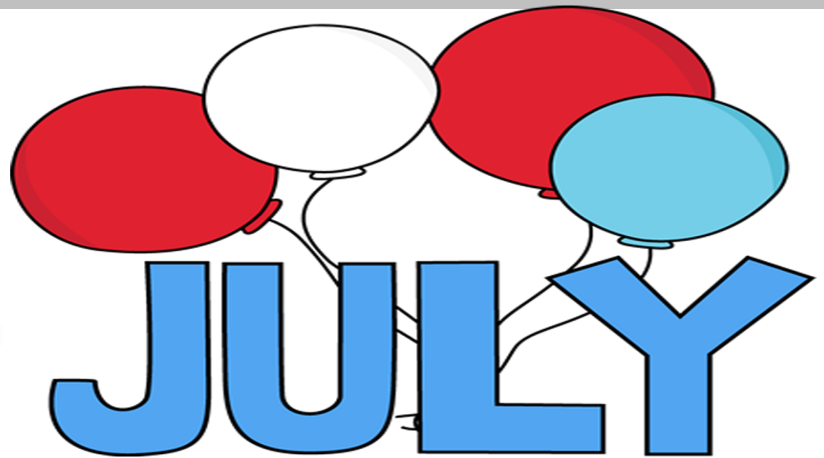

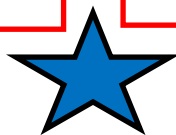

Enjoy the summer and have tons of fun.

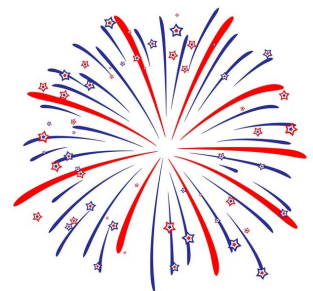
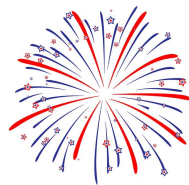
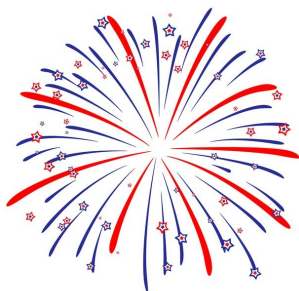

(Prepay is not mandatory - cash will still be accepted)

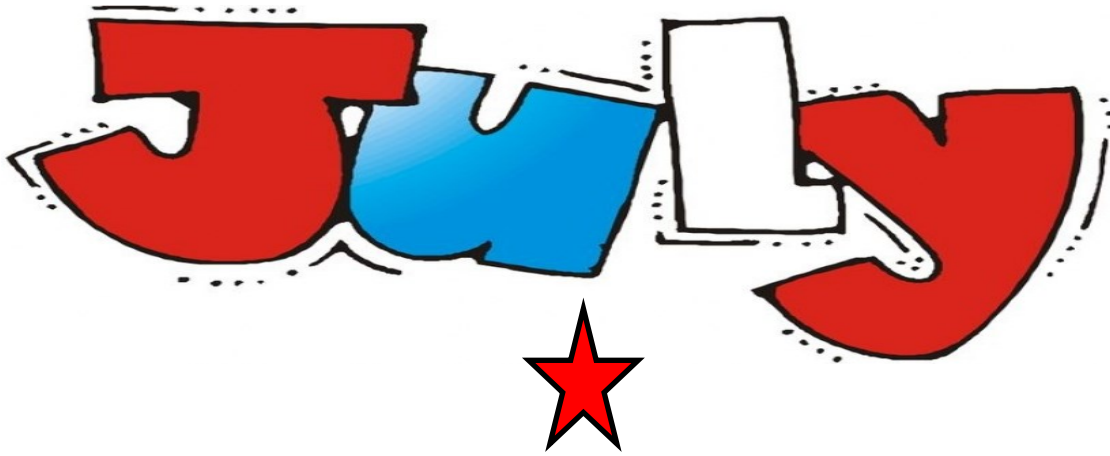

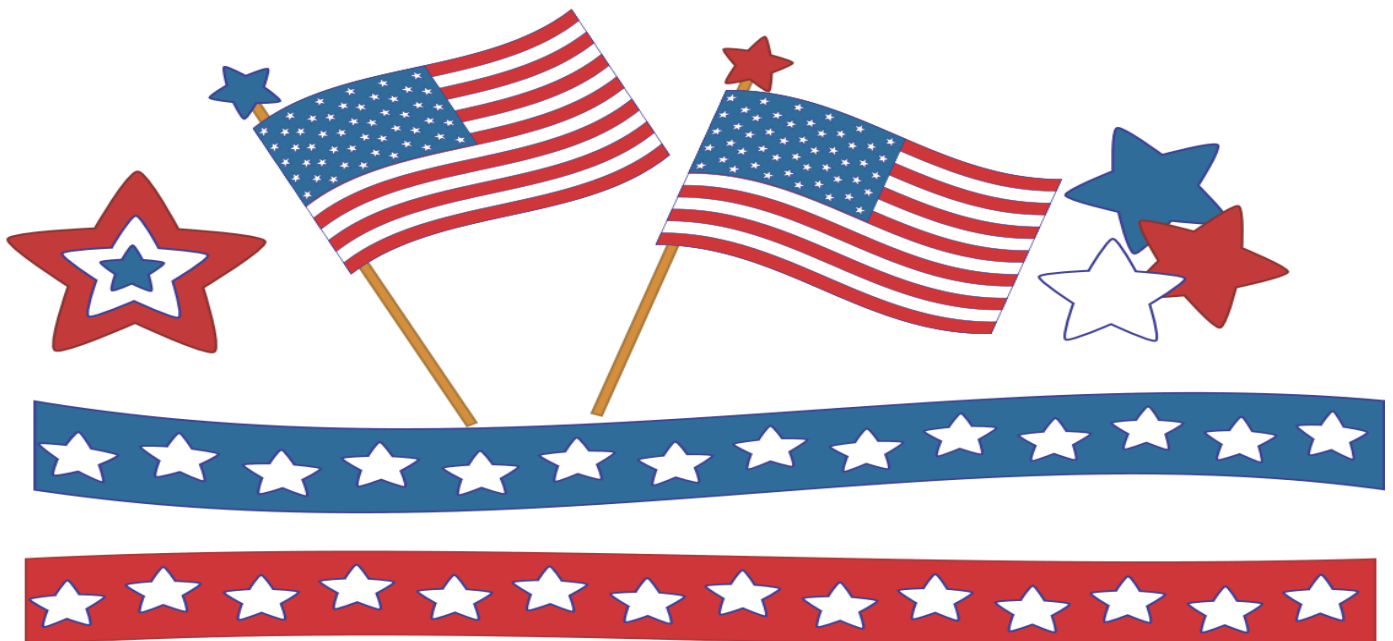

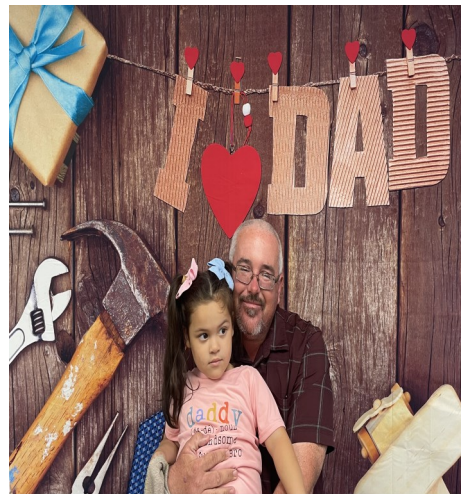
