# VPK

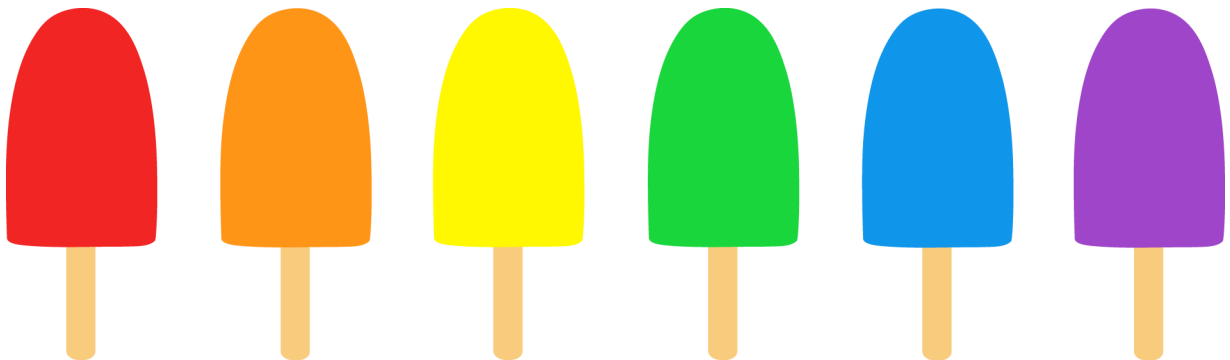

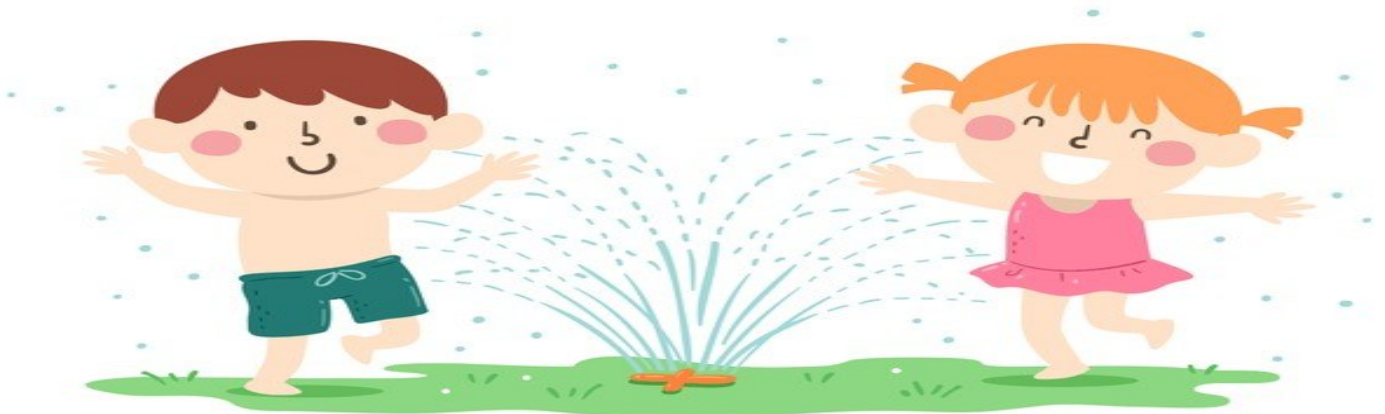
