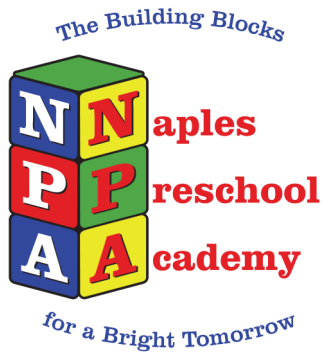

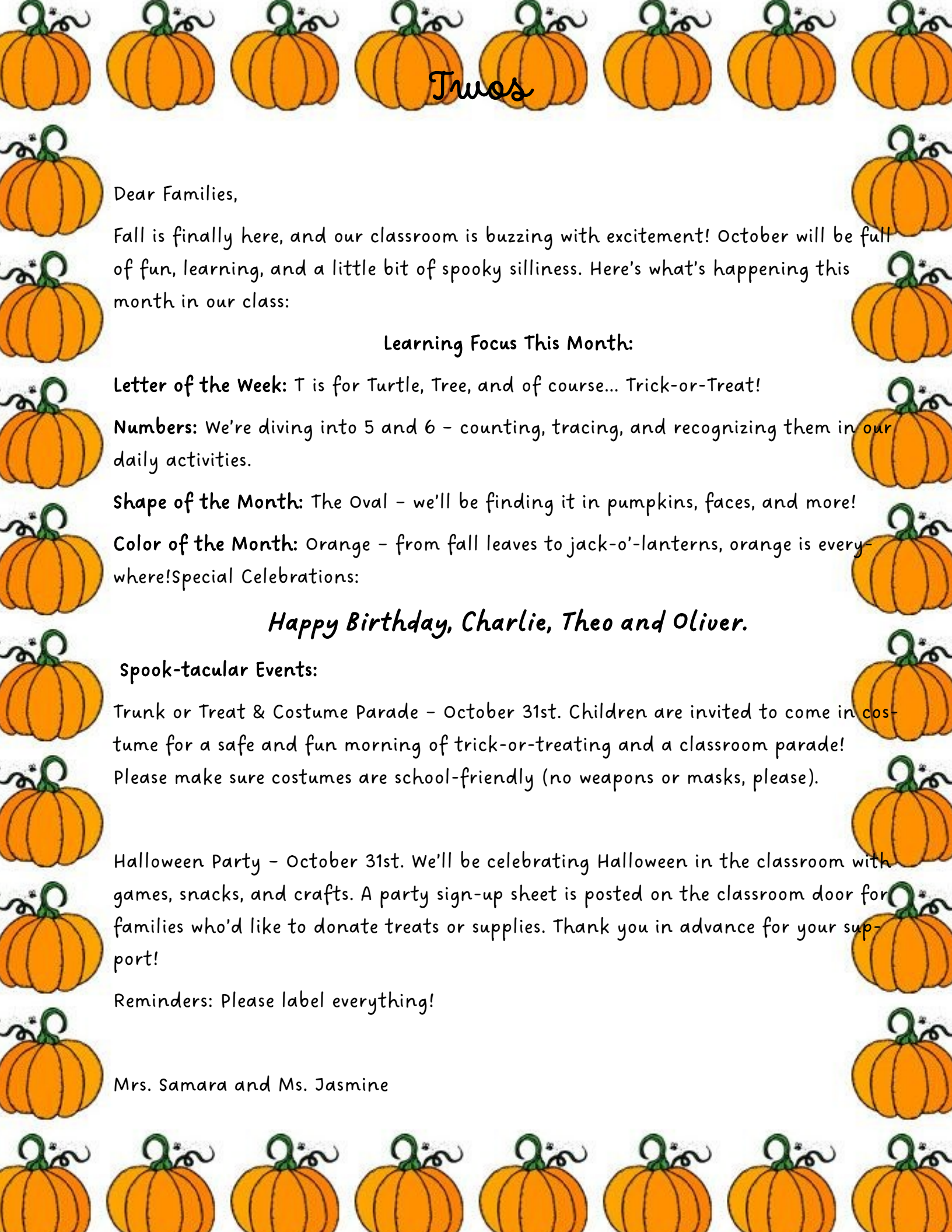

Extra clothes with name if your child has to change during the week I will send home all extra clothes on Friday so you may re-pack missing items.

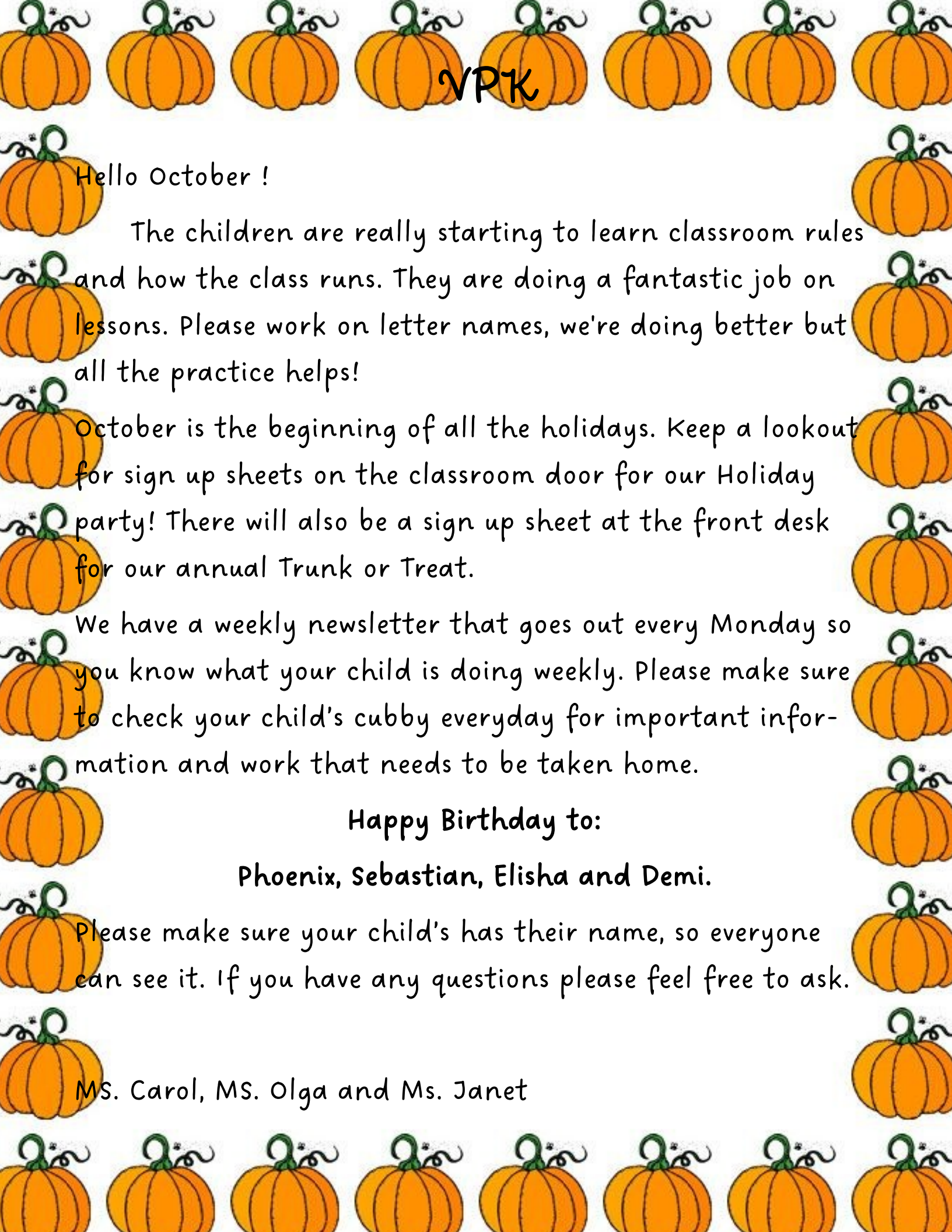
Anything your child brings from home needs to have their name on it please. If it gets lost and their name is Not on it. I am not responsible for the missing item.

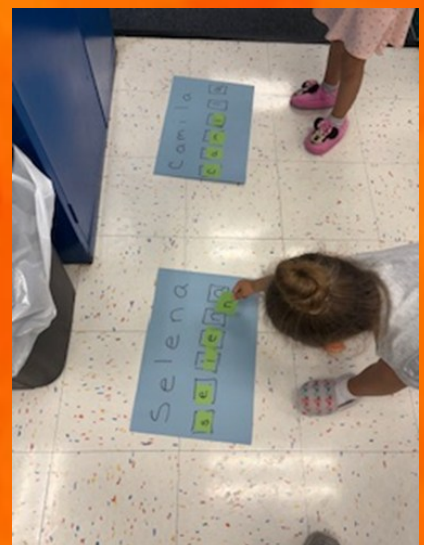
