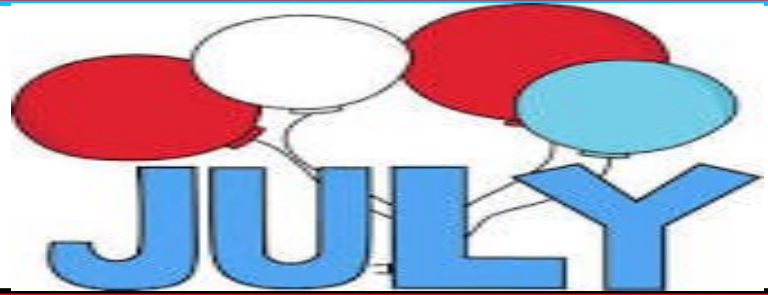

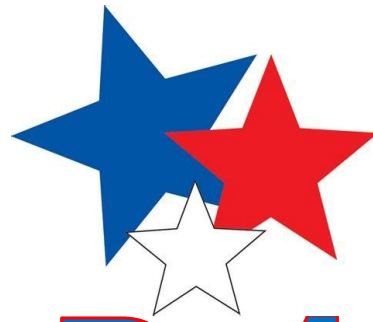
# Infants

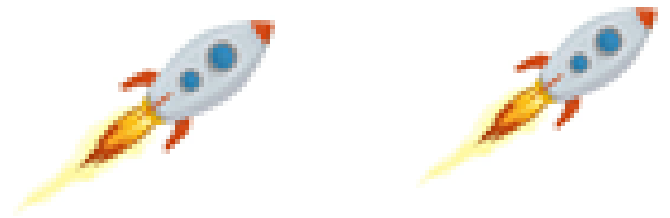
**3, 2, 1... Blast Off!**

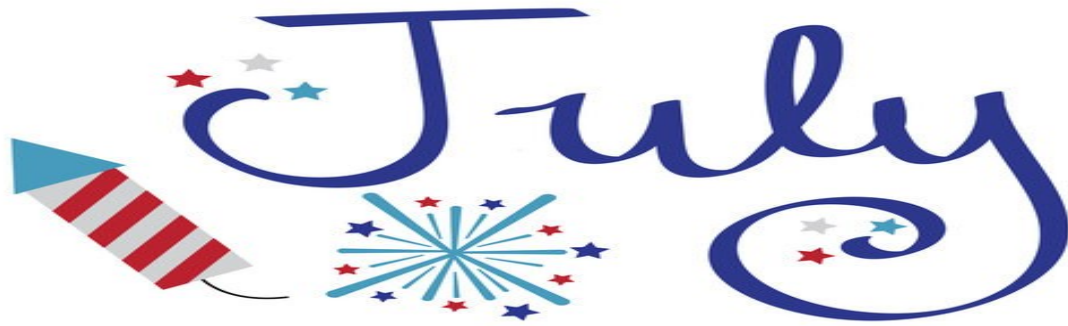

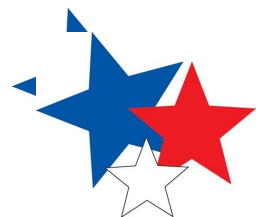
